To be eligible to register for a Binance Account and use the Binance Services, you must not be:

(i) located, incorporated, otherwise established in, resident of, a citizen of, or operating in:

United States

(ii) located, incorporated, otherwise established in, or resident of:

Canada

Netherlands

(iii) located, incorporated, otherwise established in, or resident of:

Cuba

North Korea

Iran

Crimea (as defined in US Executive Order 13685)

The so-called Donetsk People's Republic (as defined in US Executive Order 14065)

The so-called Luhansk People's Republic (as defined in US Executive Order 14065)
